DEMOLITION DERBY RACING RULES

ALL RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

1. Open to all competitors, male and female, over the age of 17 years with a current driver's license.
2. The event is started when the **RED** flag is dropped. All action must cease immediately when the fire brigade siren sounds or the **YELLOW** flag is raised.
3. Crash helmets and belts must be of an approved type and must be worn at all times.
4. All drivers must wear racing uniform or overalls. **NO THONGS, SHORTS, T SHIRTS ALLOWED.** Overalls and racing uniforms must have full length sleeves. No bib and brace overalls.
5. Any cars immobilized for longer than one minute will be deemed to be out of the event.
6. Any cars deemed (by officials) not to be partaking in the demolition of fellow competitors will be automatically disqualified.
7. Any deliberate or careless hit (deemed by officials) on a drivers' door will result in immediate disqualification
8. All decisions made by officials are final
9. Winning cars may be inspected after completion of the event before official placings are given. Placing announcements over the PA system are not binding until final inspections are done.
10. Decisions of judges, Referee and Scrutineers are **FINAL AND NON NEGOTIABLE.**

CAR SPECIFICATIONS

1. No full chassis vehicles allowed. All wheel drive vehicles (4wd Subaru wagons & the like) must have tailshaft removed. V8's are allowed.
2. All interior linings, glass, lights, trim, body moulds etc must be removed.
3. Towbars may be left on but tongues must be removed with no dangerous protrusions.
4. Plastic bumpers may be left on.
5. Original fuel tank must be completely removed unless it is positioned in front of the rear wheels. Replacement tank to be a jerry can, boat type tank or other professionally constructed fuel tank securely mounted to the vehicle, ideally in a steel cradle. Any plastic tanks must be dedicated approved boat tanks only.
6. **a.** All doors must be bolted and/or welded and/or chained shut at door handle level or below. Note: Fully welded is acceptable & we recommend that the original door locks are left in place. **(Optional).** Chains, seat belt, tape & welds are allowed around all the window frames, however the car must still comply with part **a.**
7. Boots and tailgates must be bolted and/or welded and/or chained and/or strapped shut.

CAR SPECIFICATIONS CONTINUED:

8. Vans, Utes and Wagons tailgates are optional.
9. Bonnet to be chained and or bolted shut. Bonnets must be able to be opened for scrutineering purposes.
10. **Tyres.** Standard tyres, Wintertread, regrooved & aggressive / rally type tyres are permitted.
11. Seat belts must be in good condition. Lap sash or retractable permitted but locking mechanism must be working.
12. Drivers door must be reinforced: Steel plate fixed inside the door in a way that prevents the plate from sliding out. Steel plate bolted/welded outside the door. Steel bars inside the door. Or any combination of the above. Cast iron or any brittle metals must not be used.
13. Drivers seat must be reinforced by bar in a way that will stop the seat collapsing. This is optional in utes and vans that have a firewall directly behind the seat. Vertical, horizontal & diagonal bar work behind the driver's seat, providing some roll over protection is also acceptable. This bar work does not have to be mounted to the pillars, it can be mounted to the floor, roof & inner door skins. This bar work may incorporate fuel tank & battery mounts, (This is acceptable, not compulsory).
14. Drivers doors to be red and white in colour with a large cross on it.
15. Drivers windscreen area must be covered with steel mesh.
16. Drivers door must have either steel mesh or a window net fitted.
17. All cars to be cleaned out. No loose objects, rubbish or glass.
18. Multiple batteries are permitted. Must be securely mounted with a rubber cover over the top. Enclosed battery boxes allowed.
19. Engine and gearbox mounts may be bolted and/or welded solid but original rubber mounts must remain. Engines may be chained in.
20. Radiators must be in original position.
21. Car numbers to be clearly visible from both sides. (Roof mounted or rear door area).
22. Must have a large white flag fitted within drivers reach visible from all angles. This must be easily accessed by the driver and be able to be removed when the vehicle is disabled.
23. Brakes must be effective enough to stop the vehicle.
24. Exhaust must not exit in the engine bay area & must be directed well away from any fuel tanks, side exit ideal.
25. A fire blanket within easy reach of the driver is encouraged but not compulsory. Foam padding on the driver's door may be used.

RELEASE & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In exchange for being allowed to enter the show grounds with a motor vehicle I hereby agree as follows:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I may have against the Wingham Show Society, their directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives.
2. TO RELEASE the Wingham Show Society from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that I, or my next of kin, may suffer or incur as a result of my actions due to any cause whatsoever.
3. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the Wingham Show Society from any and all liability for property damage, personal injury or death suffered by myself or by a third party as a result of (a) my use of the facilities and/or (b) my breach of the terms and conditions upon.
4. THAT THIS RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, ad assigns, in the event of my death;
5. TO OBEY all warning signs and other notices posted within the facilities.
6. Carefully follow all instructions given by the Wingham Show Society, their directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives.
7. TO NOT drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or whilst my vehicle is within the show grounds.

I have read and understood this Release and Indemnity Agreement prior to signing it and am aware that by signing this document, I am affecting the legal rights and liabilities of myself, my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns.
